

Finance/PIPS In-Processing Information Sheet

What is PIPS:

PIPS (PCS In-Processing System) is a streamlined electronic system for finance in-processing. This system replaces paper vouchers; allowing for eased finance in-processing from one's own office, digitizing all associated paperwork for centralized processing and simplified voucher correction processes.

Importance of Timely PIPS In-Processing:

Processing in the PIPS system allows for correct entitlements to start for Yokota AB, reimbursement for travel expenses, and ensures correct pay *(to prevent debts from accruing)*.

PIPS In-Processing Instructions:

1. Register CAC card with FSS/MPE Building 316 Room 121 (**Suspense: 2 business days from FSS/MPE in-process brief**)
2. Obtain Yokota AB network access working with your unit CSA and/or Comm. Squadron (**Suspense: 5 business days from FSS/MPE in-process brief**)
3. Completing PIPS process (**Suspense: 10 business days from FSS/MPE in-process brief**)
 - a. From your office computer (scanning capability must be available), using your CAC card registered for Yokota AB, log into PIPS: <https://leave.hickam.af.mil/cashforms/dd1351-2-12.asp>
 - b. For PCS in-processing click "PIPS"
 - c. Read the instructions and enter requested information. Following the prompts, directs you through the process.
