### MISSION

The 337th Air Support Flight (ASUF) provides legal, financial, education, medical and personnel administrative, and logistical support to all United States Air Force, Army, Navy, Marine Corps, Space Force, and Department of Defense (DOD) active duty military, civilian, and retired personnel in Australia and limited support to personnel in New Zealand.

### HISTORY

The 337th ASUF was activated in 1994 as the successor to Detachment 7, DoD Support Agency (DODSA), 15th Air Force Wing, Hickam AFB, Hawaii. The DODSA, Bolling AFB, Washington D.C., was created in 1986 following a joint agreement between Pacific Command, Pacific Air Forces, the Defense Intelligence Agency, and the U.S. Ambassador to Australia. DODSA was established to provide SOFA, legal, finance, transportation, and administrative support to U.S. DoD personnel and families assigned to Australia.

### HERALDRY

The 337th Service Group was constituted on 27 Jul 1942, activated on 1 August 1942, and assigned to the Provisional XI AF Services Command, Elmendorf Field AK. The unit was transferred to the Air Services Command Training Center, Fresno CA; Stinson Field, San Antonio TX; Bluethenthal Field, Wilmington NC; and Fort Lawton WA, in turn, arriving at the latter in April 1945. On 19 May 1945 the Group was transferred to Twentieth Air Force and based at Ie Shima, Ryukyus Islands. In November 1945, the Group was transferred to Eighth Air Force and based at Naha Field. The Group was inactivated there in August 1948 and disbanded in October 1948.

In 1 June 1994, the group was reconstructed and re-designated 337th Air Support Flight on 1 Jun 1994 for activation in August 1994 by HQ Pacific Air Forces.
