Definitions

- Defense Health Agency joint Combat Support Agency that provides a medically ready force and ready medical force to Combatant Commands
- Space Available Care episodic (non-recurring) healthcare for acute or sudden-onset conditions on a same-day basis
 - Examples: Illnesses, Musculoskeletal injuries
- Chronic Care healthcare that requires on-going monitoring by a Primary Care Manager for continuity of care and patient safety
 - Examples: Hypertension, Diabetes



ASD Access to Care Priority

- Priority 1 & 2 Active Duty (AD) Service Members & Family Members enrolled in TRICARE Prime
- Priority 3 Retirees & their Family Members enrolled in TRICARE Prime or Plus
- Priority 4 AD Family Members not enrolled in TRICARE Prime
- Priority 5 Retirees & Family Members not enrolled in TRICARE Prime or Plus (TRICARE Select)
- **■** Priority 6 Non-TRICARE eligible



Healthcare at 374 MDG

- Specialty clinics (General Surgery, Orthopedics etc.)
- Prenatal Care and Labor & Delivery
 - Includes the post-partum visit and the 2 week and 2 month well child exams
- Walk-in Services (Immunizations, Contraceptive clinic)
- Medication refills not available in the host nation
- Group Services (Sports/School Physicals)
 - 28 JANUARY Sports Physical Saturday!
