DRIVERS' LICENSE (USFJ 4EJ) CHECKLIST

- 1. Study carefully the attached "Driving in Japan" pamphlet; this is the current source of most of the test information.
- 2. Complete the attached 374 AW Form 50 as much as possible; have your sponsor obtain the appropriate Unit Representative signature on the form. This form is required for anyone wishing to obtain a license (dependents must have their own form).
- 3. Bring your completed 374 AW Form 50 to Pass and Registration, Bldg 993 (located adjacent to the Supply Gate) to sign up for a class. You must turn in the completed 374 AW Form 50 to sign up.
- 4. The combination of a correctly completed 374 AW Form 50 and passing the driver course will ensure your timely acquisition of a driver's license upon arrival at Yokota. Your USFJ Form 4EJ license will be available upon successful completion of the written test. Please note you are not authorized to operate a vehicle until you have a USFJ Form 4EJ license.
- 5. AFRC typically hosts the Local Conditions Orientation from 1330 1500 on Thursdays. Orientation days may be rescheduled during holidays, wing down days and wing inspections. Class room doors will be closed at 1330 and late walk-ins are not allowed.
- 6. If you have a language barrier with English and cannot read or take the test without assistance, please see how to obtain a Japanese driver's license with an interpreter (see attached How to get a Japanese Driver's License memo).
