Are you interested in starting a home business, but don't know where to start? We have answers! The most important step to get the ball rolling is to reach out to the housing office. They will provide a checklist of all the entities your need to visit prior to opening your business. If you plan on starting a business related to food or health/beauty, you will require Public Health approval. Here are the steps for your business to obtain proper approval from Public Health.

## Steps

- Send an approval application to Public Health for review. Specify exactly what you plan on doing and how you plan to do it.
- 2. Reach out to Public Health at 225-5311 to schedule a walk through of your home, your products, and your processes.
- 3. You can prepare in advance for your inspection by reviewing the guidance we inspect by. (AFI 48–117 & the Tri-Service Food Code)
- 4. If everything looks good, Public Health will sign off your checklist.
- 5. Lastly, you will be added to the Public Health inspection calendar to ensure standards are being maintained.
