## **DRIVERS' LICENSE (USFJ 4EJ) CHECKLIST**

1. Study carefully the "Driving in Japan" pamphlet; this is the current source of most of the test information.

2. Complete the 374 AW Form 50 as much as possible; have your sponsor obtain the appropriate Unit Representative signature on the form. This form is required for anyone wishing to obtain a license (dependents must have their own form). The 374 SFS Pass and Registration Office maintains a unit listing of personnel authorized to sign your 374 AW Form 50. They can be contacted at 315-225-8932 or 374SFS.S5P@us.af.mil for any questions.

3. Bring your "Driver in Japan" pamphlet, pen, paper, and your current driver's license (US or other country) to Right Start.

4. The combination of a correctly completed 374 AW Form 50 and passing the driver course during Right Start will ensure your timely acquisition of a driver's license. Please note you are not authorized to operate a vehicle until you have a USFJ Form 4EJ license.

5. AFRC typically hosts the Driver's Course from 1330 – 1600 on Thursdays as part of the Right Start program. Orientation days may be rescheduled during holidays, Wing down days and Wing inspections. Class room doors will be closed at 1330 and late walk-ins are not allowed.
