Enrollment Portability

Your TRICARE Prime enrollment is portable, meaning you can easily transfer your coverage whenever or wherever you move. You may transfer your enrollment as often as needed. Follow these simple steps to ensure you have no break in coverage when you move.

1. Do not disenroll from TRICARE Prime before you move.
2. Update your personal information in the Defense Enrollment Eligibility Reporting System (DEERS). You have two options:
 - Visit the Beneficiary Web Enrollment Web site (<https://www.dmdc.osd.mil/appj/bwe/indexAction.do>)
 - Visit the DEERS Web site (<https://www.dmdc.osd.mil/appj/address/indexAction.do>)
3. Transfer your Prime coverage within 30 days of arriving at your new location.

Within Your TRICARE Region

If you move to another Prime Service Area in the same TRICARE region, you will only need to change your primary care manager (PCM). You have two options for changing your PCM:

1. Log on to the Beneficiary Web Enrollment Web Site (<https://www.dmdc.osd.mil/appj/bwe/indexAction.do>) and follow the instructions to change your PCM.
2. Download the TRICARE Prime Enrollment Application and PCM Change Form and complete only the PCM change section. Then, submit the form to your regional contractor.

If you move to a designated TRICARE Prime Remote location, transfer your TRICARE Prime enrollment to TRICARE Prime Remote by submitting a new TRICARE Prime Enrollment Application and PCM Change Form. The enrollment transfer is effective for your whole family when your regional contractor receives the form.

You can also enroll in TRICARE Prime Remote via the Beneficiary Web Enrollment Web Site (<https://www.dmdc.osd.mil/appj/bwe/indexAction.do>).

To Another TRICARE Region

When you move to a new TRICARE region, you'll transfer your enrollment to either TRICARE Prime or TRICARE Prime Remote depending on where you live, a Prime Service Area or a designated TRICARE Prime Remote location.

In either case, you have two options for transferring your enrollment:

1. Log on to the Beneficiary Web Enrollment Web site (<https://www.dmdc.osd.mil/appj/bwe/indexAction.do>) and transfer your coverage up to 90 days before you move.
2. Download, complete and submit a new TRICARE Prime Enrollment Application and PCM Change Form to your new regional contractor once you arrive at your new location.

The enrollment transfer is effective for your whole family when your new regional contractor receives the form.
