U.S. Embassy Tokyo Outreach: Staff from the U.S. Embassy in Tokyo will be at the Taiyo Recreation Center, Bldg. 3260, Yokota AB, Japan on Wednesday the 7th of November to provide assistance in the following areas:

Tourist Passports: **Main Ball Room**. They will be accepting applications for Tourist Passports and Consular Report of Birth Abroad (CRBA) between 1000 and 1300 on a Walk-in-basis.

Arrive before 1300 with the appropriate outreach checklist and all required items (completed form, passport photo, postal money order, original and copies of supporting documents, return envelope, etc.)

Renew by mail: If you have a tourist or government passport issued after the age of 16 and within 15 years, see the Embassy website or outreach checklist for mail-in information.

Federal Benefits: Room 207. They will be accepting applications for Social Security Number, Replacement card, Name change, etc. between 1000 and 1300 on a walk-in-basis; and will answer questions about Federal Benefits (Social Security, VA, OPM, etc. also on a walk-in-basis)

374th Medical Group Pharmacy Hours:

Flu Shot Availability: Flu shots are now available for all DoD ID card holders and dependents (ages 6 months+), at the Yokota AF hospital immunization clinic. Note: Immunization clinic will be closed November 1st and 2nd due to the Base Training Exercise.

Another opportunity to get your flu shot will be at the Just in time Flu Line that will be held on 5 November 2018 at the Main entrance of the Hospital (Building 4408) from 1600-1800. This will be the front of the building facing the parking lot. (Source: 374MDG)

reminder that the current TRICARE Retiree Dental Program (TRDP) will end on December 31, 2018 and be replaced by the FEDVIP on January 1, 2019. However, enrollment is not automatic and you will have to enroll under FEDVIP during the open season which runs from November 12th to December 10th of this year.
